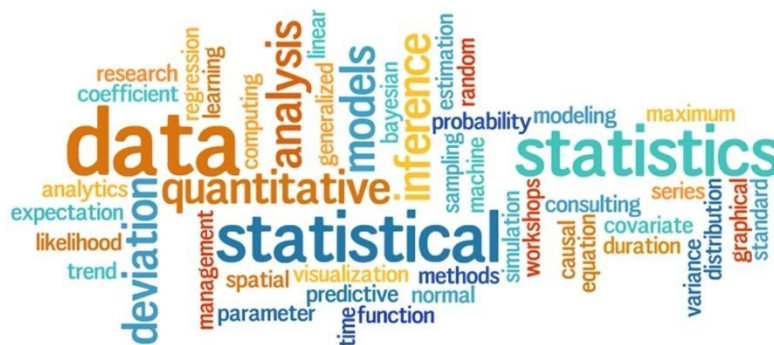

Let's begin

As our headlines say we started studying lotteries and their winning combinations over thirty years ago.

Off and on we had some remarkable success playing some lottery games with a particular system but always thought the system being used was only a part of what could really be a more comprehensive (a better and even much better) system.

Over time programmers were hired but always the deep research required more time, more study, better technology until now in the 2010's, technology is super fast compared to when we started.

With this speed and ability to number crunch and provide amazing statistical data we now have programming providing the Fantastic New Revelations on How to Win.

We looked at what was common to essentially all lottery playing systems and analyzed those things and found what was true and proven. From there we started to build the first and best most comprehensive lottery playing 21st century system.

From this beginning we inputted more than 80 review considerations using this most up to date technology by expert programmers.

ADDITIONALLY we looked at a compilation of lottery facts and lottery myths and began comparing our findings with past research.

Starting with the simplest to see let's continue.

Consecutive Numbers and **Probability** vs. **Predictability**

How often in a pick six numbers from a field of, for example, forty-nine numbers lottery, has the winning combination been comprised of six consecutive numbers?

After all **probability** (for any given drawing each number (or ping-pong ball) has the same chance of being drawn) says the odds of picking six consecutive numbers is the same as the odds of not picking six consecutive numbers, but what has **predictability** from our analysis of the 50 years of research, shown?

In all the lotteries in the U.S and around the world and over a *fifty* year review, a winning combination comprised of six consecutive numbers was **never found!**

In fact a winning combination of five consecutive numbers in it was most extremely rare.
(Four in a row was also most rare)

Yet in one state alone more than ten thousand lottery picks made by lottery players, and this for each drawing, have six consecutive numbers. For example 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6.

Probability - equal chance to occur **Predictability** - says it has a 0% history of occurrence

That which is least likely happens least often

Note – This consecutive numbers fact holds true the same in a pick-5 lottery game. For example Florida’s Fantasy Five game where only once (in over 8,000 drawings!) has there been a winning combination that was five consecutive numbers.

CONCLUSION

When making your play selections (combinations) to place on the play slips avoid playing combinations that have four, five or six consecutive numbers.

Get beat by the odds (probability) or play by the odds (predictability) and win!

Pairs

Now knowing the likelihood of any winning combination having four, five or six consecutive numbers is most extremely rare, if ever, what about how often do the winning combinations have two consecutive numbers in them?

We called this determination “**pairs.**”

Let’s review some more **predictability** by looking at three different lottery games.

Starting with the **Delaware Multi-Win-Lotto** a pick-6 game from a field of 35 numbers for example:

Here are the winning combinations from August 28, 2017 to September 27, 2017.

Note – this game is played on Mondays, Wednesdays and Fridays.

More than **70%** of the time the winning combination contained a “pair.”

Never, in this small sample, were there more than two consecutive drawings without there being a pair in the winning combination.

Overall in the **Delaware Multi-Win-Lotto** pairs hit (are in the winning combination), on average, in nearly two out of every three drawings!

Here is a snapshot of the **Pennsylvania Match 6 Lotto Game** (pick 6 of 49).

These are the winning combinations from February 16, 2017 through June 1, 2017.

They are illustrated here to review frequency of “pairs” hitting in a larger lottery and with a larger sample size. This game at that time was drawn on Mondays and Thursdays.

More recently and now as a daily game the winning combinations from 10/17/19 to 12/1/19 had a pair in the winning combination 24 times in those 46 drawings.

24/46 = 52.17%

In 20 of 30 drawings, a pair hit. This is equal to 66.7%, two out of every three drawings.

In the **Pennsylvania Match 6 Lotto Game** pairs hit on average in more than half of the drawings!

Here is a snapshot of a pick-5 lottery, the **Florida Fantasy Five Game** (pick 5 of 36). These are the winning combinations from September 10, 2018 to October 14, 2018.

In 18 of 35 drawings, a pair hit. This is equal to 51%.

More on Pairs

The pairs' indicator consideration is recommended to be used in accordance to the lottery game you are playing.

For Pick-6 games, for example the Delaware Multi-Win Lotto (a pick 6 of 35) pairs will hit more often – considerably higher than more than half the time. As exemplified pairs hit in 71% of the drawings.

Again in Delaware's Multi-Win Lotto game pairs hit in nearly two out of every three drawings.

In Pennsylvania's Match 6 Lotto Game and in New Jersey's Pick-6 game (both 6/49 games) pairs hit on average in *more than half* of the drawings.

In the pick-5 lottery games including Florida's Fantasy Five game, Virginia's Cash 5 game, Idaho's (pick 5 of 32), Wisconsin's Badger 5, in Pennsylvania's Treasure Hunt game and in essentially all pick-5 draw games (up to 43 numbers in its numbers to choose from) a pair hits, on overall average, in one out of every two drawings!

For Pick-4 games, for example Washington's Match 4 (pick 4 of 24), and Montana's Big Sky Game (pick 4 of 28), pairs hit on average a noticeably under half of the time, but still often enough that they need to be considered.

CONCLUSION

When making your play selections (combinations) to place on the play slips remember that a pair needs always to be considered.

If for example you are playing ten combinations the recommendation (depending on your state's statistical average) is to make sure that perhaps five or six of your combinations have a pair in them.

*Get beat by the odds (probability) or **play by the odds (predictability) and win!***

More Predictability

Let's review some snapshots of various games from pick-6, pick-5 and pick-4 lottery examples and consider "repeats."

Repeats are those numbers, four (in a pick-4 game), five (in a pick-5 game) or six (in a pick-6 game) that made up (were in) the last drawing's winning combination.

For example in the Pennsylvania Match 6 Lotto game:

NOTE again up until 08/29/2017, this game was not a daily played game, but played (drawn) only on Mondays and Thursday. So the consecutive drawing following the 2/23/2017 drawing was the 2/27/2017 drawing.

* The winning combination on Aug 25, 2017 (the previous drawing) was 01 09 16 17 29 35, so there was then no repeat number in the winning combination on the August 28 drawing.

9 out of 14 times a number (or numbers) from the previous drawing’s winning combination was also one of the numbers in the next drawing’s winning combination.

So in the example here a “repeat” hit much greater than half of the time at 64.2% and three of those times two repeats hit. (*Also note in 10 of the 14 drawings (71%) a “pair” hit....*)

In Delaware’s Multi-Win Lotto game **repeat(s)** hit in **more than two out of every three (67.7%) drawings**

Pennsylvania Match 6 Lotto Game 6/49 – These are the winning combinations from February 16, 2017 through June 1, 2017.

They are illustrated here to review frequency of “repeats” in a larger lottery and with a larger sample size.

Again this game was at that time drawn on Mondays and Thursdays.

More recently - the winning combinations from 10/17/19 to 12/1/19 had a repeat in the winning combination 25 times in those 46 drawings.

$25/46 = 62.5\%$

* The winning combination on February 13, 2017 (the previous drawing) was 01 04 05 06 31 41, so there was then a repeat number in the winning combination on the February 16 drawing.

Even with a bigger lottery game (up from 35 to 49 numbers in the field of numbers) a repeat hit in 15 of the 30 exemplified drawings, equal to 50% of the time and three times two repeats hit.

In **Pennsylvania's Match 6 Lotto Game repeat(s) hit** on average at **56.8%** (more than half of the time).

Now let's look at repeats and a pick-5 game.

*On 9/9/2018 the winning combination was 1,2,12,27,30. Therefore the number 30 is a repeat on the 9/10/2018 drawing.

A repeat hit in 20 of the 35 exemplified drawings, equal to 57% of the time.

In the **Florida's Fantasy Five 5/36** lottery game **repeats hit** on average in **more than half** (56.12%) of all drawings.

CONCLUSION

Repeats happen often. When making your play selections (combinations) to place on the play slips remember that a repeat needs to be considered.

Get beat by the odds (probability) or play by the odds (predictability) and win!

More Predictability

Let's review the same examples one more time and consider "crosses."

Cross Numbers (separate from and in addition to any other designation*) are those numbers that immediately precede and immediately follow each of the numbers in the previous drawing's winning combination.

Again **Delaware's Multi-Win-Lotto** exemplified:

First notice that in the winning combinations listed in 12 of the 14 there is a number or numbers bolded. So 85% of the time (drawings) there is a bolded number or numbers.

Each bolded number is a "**cross number**."

NOTE – this is a constant – meaning regardless of the lottery game being played (a pick-4, pick-5, or pick-6), "cross numbers" are those numbers that immediately precede and immediately follow each of the numbers in the previous drawing's winning combination.

Example – on August 25, 2017 the winning combination in Delaware's Multi-Win-Lotto was 01 09 16 17 29 35.

Therefore the cross numbers or "crosses" for the next drawing are 2, 8, 10, 15, 16, 17, 18, 28, 30, and 34. (As this game is a pick 6 of 35 numbers there is no number 36 in this lottery game).

*NOTE – so yes any number can have multiple designations – meaning any number could be for example a repeat and a cross. Here is such an example from Florida's Fantasy Five game

9/22/2018	2,5,6,13,17
9/23/2018	6,19,22,24,30

With its hitting on 9/22/18 and 9/23/18 the number 6 is a repeat and because it immediately follows the previous drawing's number 5, its hitting on 9/23/18 is also a cross number hit.

What is the significance of a cross number or numbers?

Consider that in the example here (Illustration 25) 22 cross numbers hit in these 14 drawings equaling more than 1.5 cross numbers hitting per drawing!

Delaware’s Multi-Win Lotto game has **cross numbers hit** on average in over **90%** of the drawings.

Here is another snapshot example regarding crosses again using the bigger **Pennsylvania’s Match-6 Lotto**

Note that the winning combination on 2/13/17 (the previous drawing to the 2/16/17 drawing) was 1, 4, 5, 6, 31, 41

A cross number hit in 24 of the 32 drawings equal to **75%** of the drawings. So in three out of every four drawings a cross number or numbers hit.

Consider that in the example here (Illustration 26) 37 cross numbers hit in these 32 drawings equaling more than 1.15 cross numbers hitting per drawing!

And in this example never more than two consecutive drawings occurred without a cross number hitting.

Pennsylvania’s Match-6 Lotto game has **one or more cross numbers hit** on average in **over four out of every five drawings**.

CONCLUSION

Cross numbers are in the winning combinations in all of our recommended to play lotteries at a very high rate. When making your play selections (combinations) to place on the play slips you should always consider the cross numbers.

*Get beat by the odds (probability) or **play by the odds (predictability) and win!***

More Predictability

All lotteries have a bell curve based on the sum of the numbers in their winning combinations where the winning combination in four out of every five drawings will fall.

For example – a pick-5 game’s winning combination might be:
6,11,19,23, 24.

The sum of this winning combination is $6+11=17+19=36+23=59+24= 83$.

We call the sums or bell curve where 80% (four out of every five drawings) falls, the “range.” Meaning that the sum of the winning combination will be in the “range” of, for example Florida’s Fantasy Five game, between 64 and 121 in four out of every five drawings.

Range – Of all possible combinations as defined by the lottery specifics, "Range" is the upper and lower window "sweet-spot" of combinations as defined by the sums of their component numbers.

For example, and again, in Florida’s Fantasy Five game, statistically in no less than 80% of its drawings, the sum of the five numbers in the winning combination will be between 64 and 121. This 64 to 121 is that lottery’s “range.”

CONCLUSION

This range can be used to significantly help make your best “favorable odds increasing” play selections.

Let’s say in making your selections (combinations) to play – and again we will use for illustrative purposes the Florida Fantasy Five game - you have selected two cross numbers, and a repeat number and then selected a fourth number that makes a pair.

Now when adding the fifth and final number, select a number that when adding it to the sum of the four numbers already selected, makes the sum of the five numbers greater than 63 and less than 122.

*Get beat by the odds (probability) or **play by the odds (predictability) and win!***
